# Introduction to Khairpur Medical College, Khairpur Mir's

Khairpur Medical College is Constituent part of People's University of Health & Science for women Nawabshah & one amongst 12 public sector Medical Colleges /Universities of Sindh.

The College was initially named as LUMHS Khairpur Medical College khairpur a part of Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences Jamshoro Sindh (LUMHS) till 2014.

It is located in Khairpur which is largest district of Sindh having 2.5 million population, the catchment area extends from left bank of river Indus to Indian border on Eastern side.

The College was established in Dec, 2012 and inaugurated by then Chief Minister Sindh Syed Qaim Ali Shah. First batch was admitted for session 2014-15 after provisional recognition of college by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council in March 2015 and got permanently recognized by Pakistan Medical Commission in January 2020.

Khairpur Medical College is ISO-9001 Certified and placed in A category of Medical colleges/Universities of Pakistan by PMC-Islamabad.

Presently 500 students are studying from 1st year to final year MBBS.

This year 8<sup>th</sup> Batch of 100 students is being admitted in MBBS for session 2021-22.

By now 200 students have graduated from this college and providing health cover to patients and public of rural area of Sindh.

The College and Hospitals are fully equipped with all teaching aids and equipment for basic & clinical training of students.

The lecture halls, laboratories, seminar rooms, museums Libraries are fully air conditioned. High quality Medical education, clinical training and skills are taught to students to produce Doctors of tomorrow.

There is system of counseling and continuous internal assessment to help students abreast with learning and simultaneous self-evaluation.

Students are advised to refrain from over use of social Media till late night as it affects learning capacity & presence in morning for Lectures, Demonstrations, Practical, Hospital postings.

Students are encouraged to participate in sports/recreational activities and directed to act upon code & conduct of College to maintain discipline.

Rapid industrialization has produced negative effects on our environment and Health of people. Upsurge of COVID-19 has posed a great challenge to Medical fraternity.
